



Apache Corporation Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) Requirements

Apache Corporation has established the following requirements for the selection, use, and maintenance of personal protective equipment (PPE) to minimize exposure to workplace hazards.

Minimum PPE

- Hard Hat
- Personal H2S Monitor
- Safety glasses with side shields
- Steel/composite-toe footwear with slip-resistant soles
- Flame-resistant clothing (FRC)

The following chart indicates applicable standards for each PPE type.

Head	Hard Hat	ANSI Z89.1
Eyes/Face	Safety glasses with side shields, splash goggles, or face shields, as applicable	ANSI Z87.1 29 CFR 1910.133
Hearing	Earplugs or earmuffs in designated areas or areas where posted signage indicates	29 CFR 1910.95
Respiratory	Dust masks, half-face or full-face respirators, supplied air respirator, or self-contained breathing apparatus (SCBA), as required	29 CFR 1910.134
Hands	Glove selection is determined by the hazard assessment or task-specific protocol, as applicable	29 CFR 1910.138
Foot	Steel/composition toe footwear with slip-resistant soles	29 CFR 1910.136 ASTM F2413 ASTM F2412
Body	Flame-resistant clothing (FRC)	29 CFR 1910.296 NFPA 2112 NFPA 2113 NFPA 70E
Fall Protection	Full-body harness with appropriate lanyard and anchor point	29 CFR 1910.140
