



## **ISNetworld Requirements for Onsite Suppliers**

Apache Corporation maintains an established partnership with ISNetworld (“ISN”), which serves as the company’s primary platform for managing contractor and supplier information, specifically related to Environment, Health, & Safety (EH&S) and insurance compliance.

All contractors/suppliers performing onsite services for Apache are required to maintain an active subscription to ISN and be connected to Apache within the ISN platform.

Contractors/suppliers who are not currently subscribed to ISN are expected to initiate a subscription. Failure to maintain an active ISN subscription will result in removal from Apache’s Approved Supplier List, and the contractor/supplier may no longer be eligible for future work opportunities.

### **Grade Requirements**

Contractors/suppliers will be graded according to their safety performance based on the components listed below:

#### **ISN Scorecard Components**

- Written Programs
- Safety Questionnaire
- Fatalities
- Total Recordable Incident Rate (TRIR)
- Days Away, Restricted, or Transferred (DART)
- Experience Modifier (EMR)

#### **Mandatory Requirements**

- Drug & Alcohol Status
- MSA / Contract
- Insurance Verification

Contractors/suppliers must maintain a passing grade of “A”, “B”, or “C” within ISN to remain on Apache’s Approved Supplier List.
