

ISNetworld Requirements for Onsite Suppliers

Apache Corporation maintains an established partnership with ISNetworld ("ISN"), which serves as the company's primary platform for managing contractor and supplier information, specifically related to Environment, Health, & Safety (EH&S) and insurance compliance.

All contractors/suppliers performing onsite services for Apache are required to maintain an active subscription to ISN and be connected to Apache within the ISN platform.

Contractors/suppliers who are not currently subscribed to ISN are expected to initiate a subscription. Failure to maintain an active ISN subscription will result in removal from Apache's Approved Supplier List, and the contractor/supplier may no longer be eligible for future work opportunities.

Grade Requirements

Contractors/suppliers will be graded according to their safety performance based on the components listed below:

ISN Scorecard Components

- Written Programs
- Safety Questionnaire
- Fatalities
- Total Recordable Incident Rate (TRIR)
- Days Away, Restricted, or Transferred (DART)
- Experience Modifier (EMR)

Mandatory Requirements

- Drug & Alcohol Status
- MSA / Contract
- Insurance Verification

Contractors/suppliers must maintain a passing grade of "A", "B", or "C" within ISN to remain on Apache's Approved Supplier List.
